- **Chemical inventory** — SDS files, hazards, expiry alerts and COSHH hazard export.
- **Samples & freezers** — visual box maps, aliquot lineage and full chain of custody (a modern alternative to Freezerworks).
- **Equipment & room booking** — QR check-in, training-gated access and conflict-free scheduling.
- **SOPs & protocols** — version control with read-and-sign records auditors ask for.
- **Risk assessments, waste, maintenance** and sustainability evidence for LEAF-style reporting.
- **Role-based access and a full audit log** across everything — one login for the whole lab.

Replaces ChemInventory, Freezerworks, a separate booking tool, spreadsheets and paper COSHH / SOP folders.
